Ineligible moving expenses:

- Expenses for work done to make your old residence more saleable;
- Any loss from the sale of your home;
- Travel expenses for house-hunting trips before you move;
- Travel expenses for job hunting in another city;
- Value of items movers refuse to take, such as plants, frozen food, ammunition, paint, and cleaning products;
- Expenses to clean or repair a rented residence to meet a landlord's standards;
- Expenses to replace personal-use items such as furniture, drapes, and carpets;
- Mail-forwarding costs (such as with Canada Post);
- Costs of transformers or adaptors for household appliances;
- Costs incurred in the sale of your old residence if you delayed selling for investment purposes or until the real estate market improved; and
- Mortgage default insurance.
